GLOBAL SPECTRUM ADDS 37 EVENTS TO CARDINALS STADIUM

NON-FOOTBALL EVENTS FILLING CALENDAR AT NEW MULTI-PURPOSE STADIUM IN GLENDALE

GLENDALE, Ariz. (June 6, 2006)-- Global Spectrum, operators of the new Cardinals Stadium, has secured 37 additional multi-day and annual non-football events for the state-of-the-art, 63,000-seat, multi-purpose complex, according to Global Spectrum's Peter C. Sullivan, General Manager of Cardinals Stadium.

"This is another step forward in our booking process and we are very pleased with the variety of public events that we have been able to secure for the stadium. These events compliment our already busy schedule and we continue to work with numerous local and national event producers to fill remaining dates," said Sullivan.

The new events announced equate to 85 event days per year and a projected 550,000 attendees. Additionally, the combined events will bring in approximately 10,000 exhibits to the Glendale venue over the course of multiple years.
